

## Hadith Jibril ﷺ



'Umar bin Al-Khattab (May Allah be pleased with them) said,

Once we were sitting in the company of Messenger of Allah ﷺ when there appeared a man dressed in very white clothes and having extraordinary black hair. No signs of fatigue of journey appeared on him and he was known to none of us. He sat down facing the Prophet ﷺ leaning his knees against the knees of the Prophet ﷺ and placing both of his palms over his two thighs and said, *"Muhammad ﷺ, Tell me about Islam"*. He ﷺ replied, *"Islam is to testify that none has the right to be worshipped but Allah, and that Muhammad ﷺ is the Messenger of Allah. That you observe the daily prayers. That you purify your wealth from excess. That you fulfill the annual fast of Ramadan. That you perform the Pilgrimage to the House, provided you have resources to make the journey"*. Jibril replied, *"You have spoken the truth"*. We were surprised to see that he had asked him and confirmed the correctness of the answers. Jibril then asked, *"Tell me about faith"*. He ﷺ said, *"It is to believe in Allah, His angels, His Books, His Messengers and the Last Day and that you believe in destiny, its bad and good consequences"*. Jibril said, *"You have spoken the truth"*. Jibril then enquired, *"Tell me about excellence"*. He ﷺ said, *"It is to worship Allah as if you are seeing Him; and although you are incapable of seeing Him, He sees you"*. Jibril asked further, *"Inform me about the Hour "*. He ﷺ replied, *"I have no more knowledge than you"*. Jibril said, *"Inform me about some of its signs"*. He ﷺ said, *"That a woman will give birth to her own master. That you will find barefoot, naked, poor shepherds competing with one another in constructing higher and higher buildings"*. Then he departed. The Messenger of Allah kept silent for a while then he said to me, *"Umar, do you know who the questioner was?"* I replied, *"Allah and His Messenger know better"*. The Prophet ﷺ said, *"He was Jibril . He came to you to teach you your religion"*.
